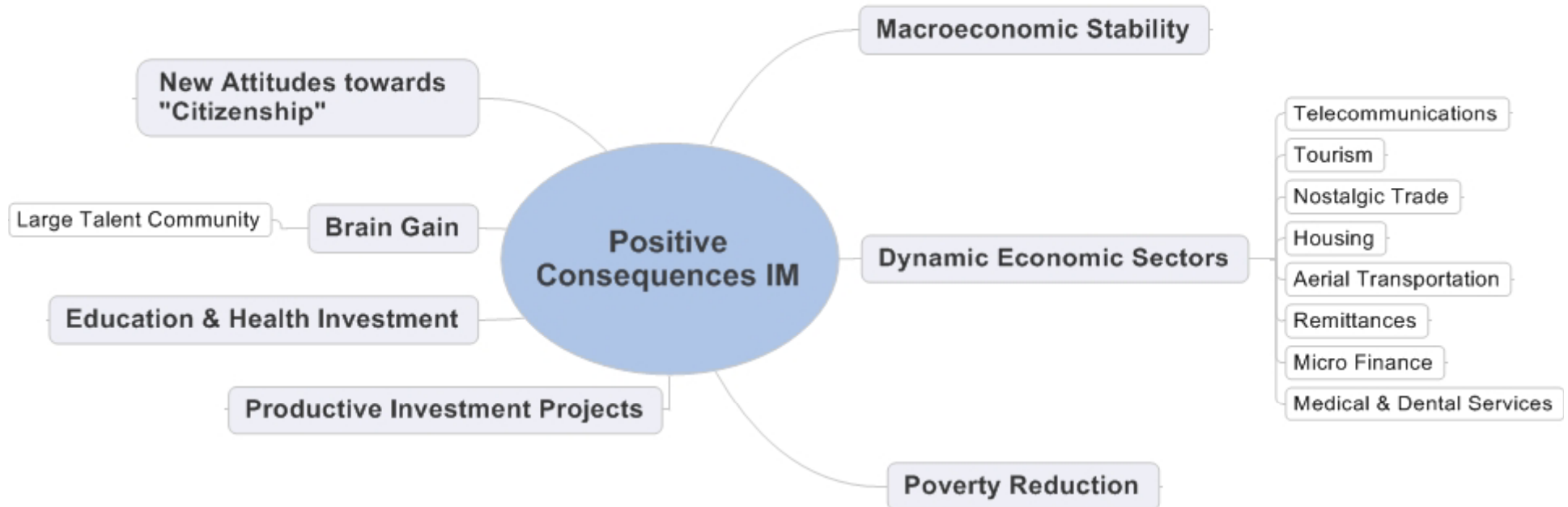

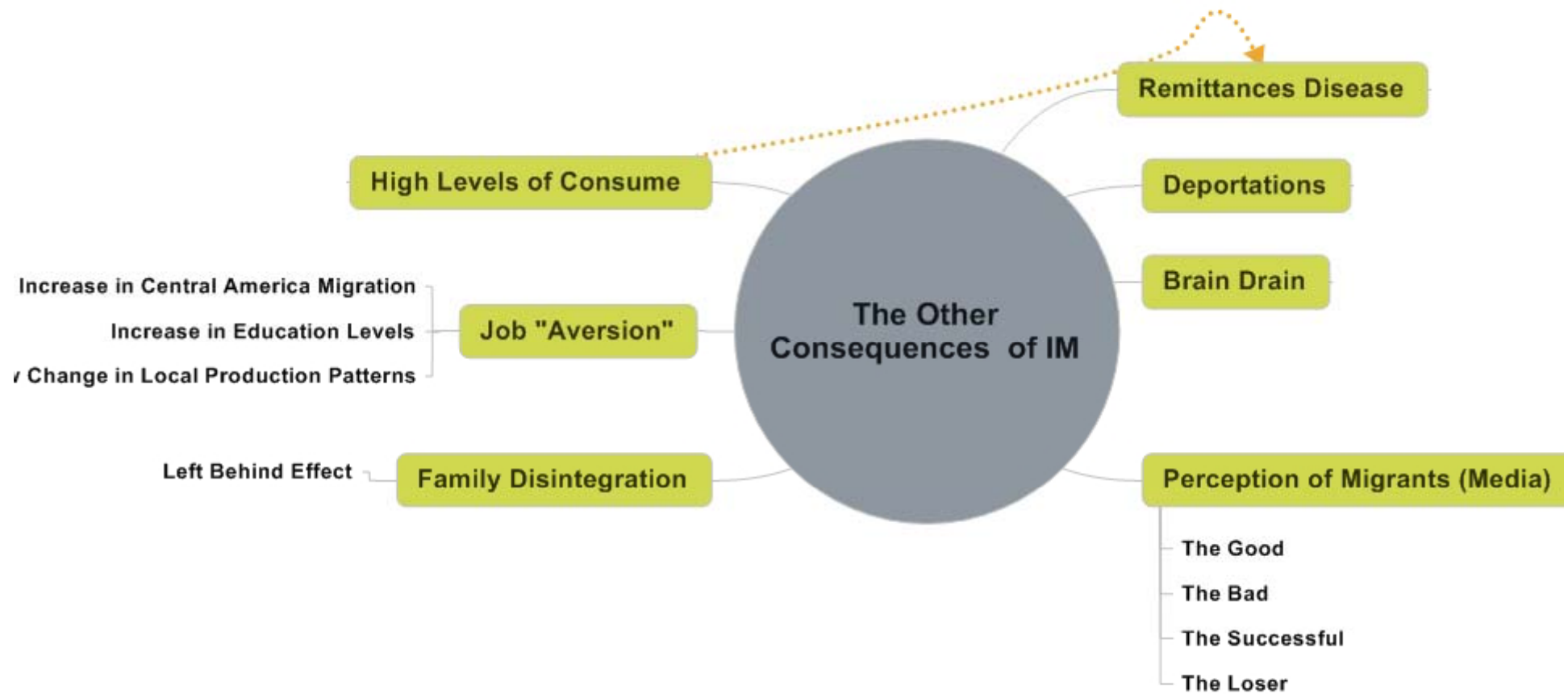

# The International Migration in El Salvador

- ▶ 30 years of IM
  - Army Conflict (1979–1991)
  - Economic Transition (After Peace Agreement, 1991–1999)
  - New Migrants of the Millenium
    - Economic
    - Natural Disaster
    - Attraction Factors
    - Reunification of Families
- ▶ Results
  - 25–30% Population Overseas (2–2,5 M / 7 M) Census 2007
  - 1 / 4 families recieve Remmittances

- ▶ The Human Development and Migration Area (2007–2008)
  - Foster the HD & Migration Issues
  - Advocacy in Migration Issues
  - Promote partnership and Leverage Key Actors
  - Promote the Best Practices
- ▶ Two Ongoing Projects
  - 1.5 € Million, Funding by EC
    - Strength the capacity of Academia, Government and NGO practitioners
  - Joint Program, IOM, UNICEF, UNFPA and UNDP as Implementing Partner
    - Impact in the families (left behind) and Public Policies
